## 2017 Voting Record

### Description of each vote included

**HB 1703** – The “Choosing Childbirth” act. In short, requires the government to provide grant opportunities to non-profit organizations that promote a woman carrying a pregnancy to term, encouraging childbirth. These grants are specifically not available to any organizations that provide information on abortion care options.

**SB 30** – Expanding signage at clinics that provide abortion care. The following verbiage is to be added to signage posted in waiting areas of clinics that provide abortion care:

There are public and private agencies willing and able to help you carry your child to term, have a healthy pregnancy and a healthy baby and assist you and your child after your child is born, whether you choose to keep your child or place him or her for adoption. The State of Oklahoma strongly encourages you to contact them if you are pregnant.
